Monday 6th of February

Suburra

(Sollima 2015) 135 min

A gangster known as "Samurai" wants to turn the waterfront of Rome into a new Las Vegas. All the local mob bosses have agreed to work for this common goal. But peace is not to last long. The suburbia, a rough neighbourhood of Rome, is the scene of an ambitious real estate project. But, with the state, Vatican and the mafia involved things are not what they seem.

Grande Sogno

(Placido 2009) 101 min

1968, in Rome, the famous university La Sapienza' got occupied by a group of students. This group of students is led by Libero, son of unemployed workers of Fiat, who wants to politically change the future of the Italian Youth. In between the opposition of the police and social fights, Libero falls in love with the upper class student Laura. But she will soon meet another guy who will take Libero's place in her heart, Nicola, without realising that this new charming guy is nothing else than an infiltrate from the police...



Monday 20th of February

Sangue Pazzo

(Giordana 2008) 150 min

It is the fascinating story of two renowned actors of Fascist cinema, Osvaldo Valenti and Luisa Ferida - executed by partisans. Idolised by the public, a famous and infamous couple on and off screen. Stars of the Fascist endorsed 'white telephone' cinema, their private lives were as wild as the villainous, depraved characters they portrayed. Driven by an uncontrollable lust for sensation and all-consuming cocaine habits. Well at last that was the rumour. They denied every charge levelled against them, claiming the crimes attributed to them were inventions, the fruits of envy.



Monday 27th of February

Perlasca – An Italian Hero

(Negrin 2002) 126 min

This is a 2002 Italian drama, directed by Alberto Negrin, about Giorgio Perlasca, an Italian businessman working in Hungary for his government. After Italy surrendered to the Allies, he took refuge in the Spanish Embassy. Aware of the threat to Jews, he first began to help them find shelter in Spanish safe houses.

After the Spanish ambassador moved to Switzerland, Perlasca posed as the Spanish consul, tricking Nazi officials and saving the lives of more than 5,000 Jews in Hungary in 1944 during the Holocaust.

Un Fantastico Via Vai

(Pieraccioni 2013) 94 min

Arnaldo, Anita and the twins, are a quiet, normal, middle class family. Arnaldo is at that stage of his life where nostalgia for the period as a student becomes stronger. After a misunderstanding his wife throws him out of the house! This is his big chance for a personal "time machine". He and three friends decide to go to live in a student house: two worlds compared two ways of seeing the future...



Monday 13th of March

Lezioni di Cioccolato

(Cupellini 2007) 113 min

Unscrupulous building contractor Mattia has style, designer suits, a nice car and a gorgeous girlfriend. He illegally hires Kamal, who falls from a roof and finds himself in hospital encased in plaster. It transpires that, in a chocolate-making competition, Kamal has won a place on a course at a local factory. Mattia finds himself with a dilemma: face the police or stand in for Kamal.

Una Moglie Bellissima

(Pieraccioni 2007) 93 min

Mariano and Miranda's happy life running the vegetable stand in a small Tuscan town is disrupted when a passing photographer spots the gorgeous Miranda and surreptitiously takes pictures of her. He tempts Miranda with fame and money to get her to pose for a calendar quickly transforming her into an object of desire when the calendar is eventually published



Monday 27th of March

Viaggio Sola

(Archibugi 2009) 102 min

Two men with virtually nothing in common strike up the closest of friendships but must deal with the impending shadow of mortality. Successful screenwriter Alberto checks himself into the hospital complaining of chest pains while Angelo winds up in the same room next to Alberto. The patients become acquainted, and before long they begin swapping confidences...



Monday 3rd of April

Principe Abusivo

(Siani 2013) 97 min

Princess Letizia lives in the castle of a small city with her father, the King and the Chamberlain. The young girl is sad and frustrated: she's being ignored by both the gossip magazines and her subjects. The King orders the Chamberlain to prepare a plan. All she has to do is pretending to fall in love with a poor Neapolitan wretch, create a scandal, and all the magazines will start talking about her.
