**Ora o Mai Più**

(Pellegrini 2003) 96 min

David, a physics student, lives in a parallel world made out of books and theories totally apart from the daily routine. Everything starts to change after participating to a student assembly where he meets Viola. This young man suddenly falls in love with Viola who is actually his best friend's girlfriend. The events bring David to join the occupation of a community center, and even the subversive actions of student riots.



**Tuesday 7th of February**
